Pongo Congress Award for Indonesians

Application deadline until 1st May 2010

The foundation provides this award for attendance at a Congress abroad Indonesia for Indonesian students, researchers and conservationists. The congress should be related to *primate research* or *conservation of wildlife or natural resources*. Award amount will be of 10 million Indonesian Rupiah for inscription, transportation and accommodation costs to attend the congress. This award is meant to provide Indonesian nationals with the opportunity to exchange expertise with international researchers and conservationists, stimulating the quality of their work to meet international and scientific standards.

Requirements

- > Application form ([click here](#)) must be fully submitted in English.
- > Additional sections may be included in the application form where relevant but the total narrative should not exceed 750 words.
- > Congress must begin between 15th May 2010 and 15th May 2011.
- > Applicants must be formally affiliated with an institution that can assure that the funds are used appropriately (e.g. Animal Centre, University, Foundation, established Field Program).

Application procedure

- > Include your curriculum vitae (in English, maximum 3 A4 pages). Please include educational background, current position, relevant experience, grants and/or awards received, presentations and publications.
- > Include one recommendation letter (in English) by senior researcher or conservationist.
- > Application form, curriculum vitae and recommendation letter must be submitted in *.pdf format to info@orangutan.nl (to convert your files into *.pdf format please visit www.pdfonline.com or use office 2007 function "save as..."). Hardcopies that arrive by post at the foundation will not be considered.

Selection criteria

- > Priority will be given to applicants who propose to give an oral or poster presentation at the congress.
- > Merit will be the primary criteria for the consideration of the award.

Completion

- >The recipient of award must agree to submit a brief final report (1 A4 page) within 2 months of the end of the congress and one picture during its professional activity.
- > The foundation reserves the right to withhold the award in case applications do not meet quality criteria.
